## New Life's 1 Year Prayer and Bible Reading Plan

## **PRAYER**

Prayer means communicating with God. *Daily prayer offers us a powerful anchor for all of life's storms*. The Apostle Paul challenged us to "pray without ceasing." (1 Thessalonians 5:17) That reminds us over time prayer becomes second nature to us as we grow deeper in our relationship with God the Father, in the name of Jesus, and in the power of the Holy Spirit. As with any discipline, prayer doesn't come naturally for most of us. If we're new followers of Jesus, we might find it challenging to pray for five minutes at a time, while those who have trusted Jesus as Savior and Lord for decades might pray for an hour or two at a time, and then be praying through the daily joys and challenges of life.

This much is sure: **Prayer only becomes an anchor for us as we engage it intentionally!** Here are two potential "frameworks" for your intentional prayer times. I have used both over the years and each has helped me to pray more intentionally, with greater discipline, and helped me grow closer to God:

"ACTS + I" The acronym ACTS + I stands for the words:

Adoration

Confession

Thanksgiving

Supplication

Intercession.

If you plan to pray for five minutes, invest one minute in adoration or praising God for who He is. Then invest one minute in confessing your sins to God. (That means to admit them to God, and includes asking Him to forgive your sins and give you the strength overcome them.) Next, thank God for your blessings, and every good thing He has provided you. Supplication means asking God to provide your needs and the needs of your family and friends. Intercession means praying for the lost, and praying for those who have special needs for healing prayer or deliverance from evil. This framework expands as you increase your time in prayer. If you have ten minutes, increase each area by a minute, and if you have an hour you invest more time proportionately in each area.

"The Hour That Changes The World" Dick Eastman wrote a book by this name, which has transformed my prayer life over the past couple years. Dr. Eastman's model assumes an hour of prayer, which he divides into twelve, five-minute segments. While similar to "ACTS + I," you invest the allotted time in twelve areas instead of five. The twelve areas are:

Praise
 Waiting on the Lord
 Confession
 Praying Scripture
 Watching
 Intercession
 Petitions
 Thanksgiving
 Song
 Meditation

11. Listening 12. Praise

Some overlap exists between Dr. Eastman's model and the ACTS + I model. Praise and adoration are the same. Confession, intercession, and thanksgiving are the same in both. Petitions are the same as supplication. The areas that differ are: Waiting on the Lord, which is simply waiting and telling God you are available to Him. Praying Scripture is selecting a passage of Scripture and praying through it by asking God to grant you its blessings, or strengthen you to meet its challenges. Watching is a time of spiritual observation, when you ask God to equip you for any spiritual battles you might be facing. Song is singing to God. Meditation means reflecting on a passage of Scripture in God's presence. Listening means waiting on God with open ears to hear anything He wants to tell you.

If you don't have an hour to pray, start with twelve minutes. I found my intentional daily prayer time increased from about forty-five minutes each day to about an hour and a half when I started using this model for prayer. (I change the order a bit, and include an intentional time of asking God to fill me with the Holy Spirit. I also extend the times of intercession, supplication, and listening.) The goal is not simply to pray longer, but to experience deeper relationship with God. Investing time with Him daily and throughout the day, helps us grow deeper in our walk with Him. Because we are combining Prayer and Daily Bible Reading, if you use Dr. Eastman's model, you will have a specific passage of Scripture you can pray through each day!

I pray each of us will know God better, love Him more fully and serve Him more faithfully as we invest time in prayer and Bible reading each day. You will likely pursue these disciplines on your own, but you might want to do them as a family, or with an accountability partner. In addition, all of us who engage this effort will be working "together," because of our common reading plan. God's richest blessings as you anchor your life deeper in God, and grow in faith, hope and love as you pray and read God's word daily!

## **DAILY BIBLE READING**

Below are 366 daily readings, which will deepen your knowledge and understanding of the entirety of God's word in the Bible, as well as Jesus' life, teaching, death and resurrection. While we will read through the Bible from start to finish, we will also invest time in the Gospels—the records of Jesus' time on earth—every day. As we read, let's give the Holy Spirit permission to apply what we read each day to transform us from the inside out. Then we will become the "Bibles" others "read" as they see us living more and more like Jesus.

The readings are self-explanatory. Simply read the passages assigned for each day, and check off each one as you complete it. The most important day for you will be the day *after* you miss a daily reading. The tendency of human nature is to say, "I missed a day, so I might as well quit." This will be even truer if you miss two or three days. I suggest if you miss a day or two or ten, you pick up on the date for the reading, and proceed from there. You can pick up the missed readings later, or leave them unread. Better to miss a few days and then continue forward, than to miss a few days and give up! (If you want to go a little deeper with each day's readings, Pastor Chris has provided a brief commentary on each chapter we read on his blog: chrismarshallresources.com.)
